Membership runs from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> December in each calendar year.

To enable us to keep our records up to date, please complete a membership form every time you renew your membership of the club.

Full membership of the South Wales Mountaineering Club is open to everyone over the age of 18. If you are aged between 7 and 17 years of age, we invite you to join our Junior section of the club. Juniors must be accompanied to all Club meets by a responsible adult.

The club is affiliated to the British Mountaineering Council. As a club member, you agree to your membership details (as given above) being passed to the British Mountaineering Council. Our online bulletin board publishes a list of members' names. If you do not wish your name to appear on the bulletin board users' list, you must notify <a href="mailto:comms@swmc.org.uk">comms@swmc.org.uk</a> within 7 days. (Note: this will mean that other members cannot send you a "private message" using the bulletin board). It is not currently our policy for Junior Members to have bulletin board access, although they may "opt in" to the email lists.

Information regarding club events is made available on the SWMC website and online bulletin board. It is standard to send official club communications by email. If you require such communications by post, please advise the club Secretary of your requirements (please remember that communication by post costs the club and the environment, so we ask that you make such a request only if absolutely necessary).
